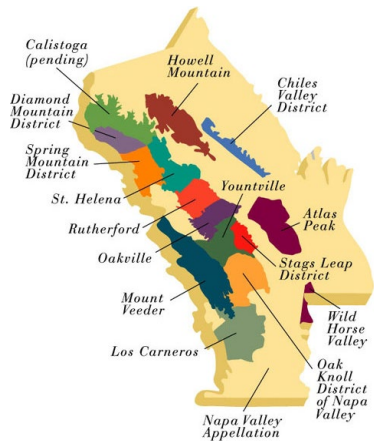




Cedar Brook Sauvignon blanc
