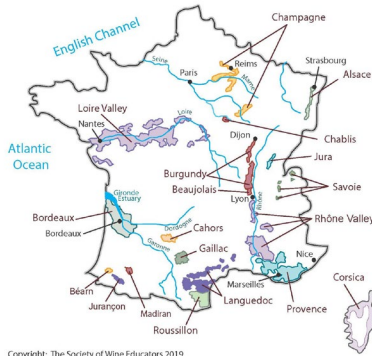

Again notes of dark berries but also traces of some minerality in the trailing edge. Lovely solid wine.

Aging: 12 months in oak barrels.
