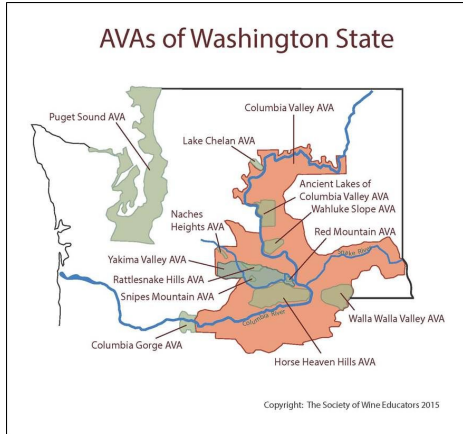




Northwest Ridge Barrel Cuvee
